About the School District

The school district serves 1,300 students in four buildings located in the communities of Wittenberg, Birnamwood, and Elderon. Students are served in two K-8 elementary/middle schools, one K-4 elementary facility, and a 9-12 high school. High school students may also access an in-house alternative program.

The district receives strong support from parents and the community. The district boasts of a state-of-the-art aquatic and fitness center built and supported by the community. The district also operates a Nature Center accessible to all students to supplement classroom instruction. The school district is proud of its extensive course offerings that provide opportunities for students to explore varied career options.

The district is known for its excellence in music and special education services. Small class sizes at all levels are a hallmark of the district, which allows teachers and staff to provide students with extensive individual attention. Technology is widely available and is incorporated throughout the curriculum. The high school houses a two-way interactive distance learning lab and is a member of the Irving network.
